

**GEORGE McDANIEL, PRIVATE**

**Company "C" Thirteenth Regiment, West Virginia Infantry Volunteers**

George McDaniel enrolled in Company "C" 13th W. Va. Infantry on 29 Sep 1863 at Barboursville, W. Va. He mustered out 22 June 1865 at Wheeling.

Born May 7, 1845, George was the son of Alexander and Mary (Mourning) McDaniel of Mason County, W. Va.

On 10 Oct 1867, George married Rebecca J. Fridley, born in Alleghany County, Virginia, the daughter of Gideon and Ruth "Lucy" (King) Fridley. Some of their children were James H. (Span-Am War Vet); Lewis Camel, Alexander, Edgar M., Mary A. "Annie," Adeline "Ada," and Isabel. At the time of the 1900 census, Rebecca stated she had given birth to 12 children, 5 of whom were living.

George died January 14, 1922 at Ambrosia, W. Va. and is buried at Brighton Cemetery, Mason County. His wife, Rebecca, died 11 Sep 1922.
